


The M9 ACE (Armored Combat Earthmover) was produced by BMY Combat Systems, and was first fielded by the U.S. Army in 1986. It has since been embraced by the USMC, as well as a few allied nations, and has seen action in the Persian Gulf wars of 1991 and 2003. This air-droppable engineering vehicle was designed to move earth, and fast. The unique hydropneumatic suspension allows the front end of the vehicle to tilt up or down and dig in with it's dozer blade, the latter of which raises up and allows the 8.7 cubic yard capacity bowl to be filled with earth using the scraper blade. This can serve as a ballast, increasing it's weight up to 55,000kg) from a basic weight of 37000 lbs (17000kg), allowing it to perform heavier earth-moving operations, or the ACE can move it's cargo of dirt to another location and push it out of the front end. The ACE is primarily used to dig emplacements for AFV's & artillery, dig tank ditches, breach berms, construct berms, repair roads, and clear obstacles.

- Keep out of reach of small children. Children must not be allowed to suck any part, or pull vinyl bag over their heads.









APPLYING DECALS

- 1.Clean the model surface with a wet cloth.
- 2.Cut out each decal design from sheet, and dip it in tepid water for 15~20 sec.
- 3. Hold the backing sheet edge and slide decal onto the model.
- 4. Move decal into position by wetting decal with finger.
- 5. Press decal gently down with a soft cloth until excess water and air bubbles are gone.


